
The Abu Dhabi National Oil Company is one of the world's leading energy companies.

WE EXPLORE & PRODUCE

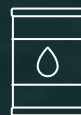
We produce around 3 million barrels of oil and 9.8 billion standard cubic feet of raw gas per day, which places us among the largest energy producers in the world.

We are committed to increasing our production capacity to 3.5 million barrels of oil per day by 2018. We continually implement innovative technologies that enable us to enhance recovery and ensure improved production efficiency.

EXPLORATION & PRODUCTION

We have 5 businesses that are responsible for all aspects of our oil and natural gas exploration, evaluation, development and production.

ADNOC Onshore

ADNOC Onshore is the leading producer within ADNOC Group, producing 1.6 million barrels of oil and 5.6 billion cubic feet of gas per day. The company operates eleven major fields in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

ADNOC Offshore

ADNOC Offshore is responsible for the development and delivery of oil and gas resources in Abu Dhabi waters. It operates five major offshore fields, including Umm Shaif, Lower Zakum and Upper Zakum, and has a total production capacity of 1.4 million barrels of oil per day.

ADNOC Drilling

ADNOC Drilling is the largest drilling contractor in the Middle East, and has drilled more than 7,200 wells. The company provides a comprehensive portfolio of drilling, work-over and well maintenance services through its expansive fleet of over 90 rigs.

Al Dhafra Petroleum Operations Company Ltd.

Al Dhafra Petroleum Operations Company was established in 2013 to develop onshore and offshore oil fields in three concession areas. Oil production is expected to commence in 2018.

Al Yasat Petroleum Operations Company Ltd.

Al Yasat Petroleum Operations Company is an onshore and offshore oil development company which is focused on developing new offshore and onshore concession areas in Abu Dhabi. Oil production is expected to commence in 2018.



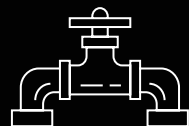
WE PROCESS & REFIN

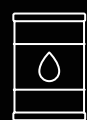

PROCESSING & REFINING

We have 7 businesses that are responsible for all aspects of processing, refining and transforming our oil and gas into a variety of products that enhance our quality of life.

ADNOC Refining

ADNOC Refining is a leading oil refining company, with a total production capacity of 922,000 barrels per day. It specializes in crude oil and condensate refining, supply of petroleum products, and production of granulated sulphur.

Borouge

Borouge is an innovative chemical and plastics solutions provider, with a total production capacity of 4.5 million tons of polyolefin per year, specializing in the development of sophisticated, value-added plastics.

ADNOC Fertilizers

ADNOC Fertilizers is the Middle East's leading producer and supplier of granular urea, the world's most widely used nitrogen fertilizer. The company produces up to 5,800 metric tons of urea per day, which is marketed and sold to local and international markets.

ADNOC Gas Processing

ADNOC Gas Processing is a major supplier of gas and gas-related products, and operates one of the largest gas processing plants in the world, which has a total processing capacity of 8 billion standard cubic feet of gas per day.

ADNOC Sour Gas

ADNOC Sour Gas is the world's largest ultra-sour gas development project, producing 1 billion standard cubic feet of gas per day and 3.5 million tons of sulphur per year. The company provides 10 percent of the UAE's natural gas, which helps to provide water and electricity to more than 200,000 houses.

ADNOC LNG

ADNOC LNG is a gas processing and LNG production company which operates at ADNOC's operational hub on Das Island. The company produces 8 million tons of LNG, LPG, paraffinic naphtha and liquid sulphur per year and also supplies 1 billion standard cubic feet of gas per day to the UAE national grid.

ADNOC Industrial Gas

ADNOC industrial gas is an industrial gas production company which supplies nitrogen and liquid oxygen to the UAE oil and gas sector.
